We have and to hold the same to the said Miles D. Carrington and his heirs and assigns forever. We hereby warranting that the title so conveyed is clear, free and unincumbered, and that we will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.

And I, Louisa Rehberg wife of the said William Rehberg in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid, do remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said grantee all my rights by way of dower or otherwise, in and to the above granted premises.

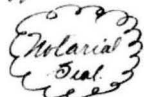
